*(VII) It is important to note here that, the respondent No.4 was given promotion by order dated 17.01.2019 and was given posting at Partur, however, the respondent No.4 has not*

*joined at Partur and managed to get the said order cancelled and get her choice posting at Jalna by order dated 12.02.2019.”*

10. Impugned transfer order is silent on special reasons and exceptional circumstances.

11. Thus, the applicant has made out a strong prima facie case for grant of stay to the impugned order.
