With all these facts, the Id. C.P.O. pointed out at P.B., Pg. No. 32 i.e. Residence Certificate by Secretary, Gram Panchayat is placed in respect of respondent no. 3 which shows that he is resident of Shahpur.

In view of all these facts, a representation has been made by applicant to S.D.O., Achalpur on 13/08/2018 at P.B., Pg. No. 110 (Annexure-A-8).

The discussion in foregoing paras are clear that decision is to be made based on the various Government documents and so S.D.O., Achalpur is directed to dispose off the representation of the applicant dated 30/08/2018 **within four weeks from the date of this order.** If aggrieved by SDO's order, the applicant is at liberty to approach the Tribunal.

In view of this situation, it is directed that till the decision of representation by applicant, Status-quo as on today regarding selection of Police Patil and joining related to this list be maintained.

Hence, the O.A. is disposed off with no order as to cost.
