"All the O.As. are partly allowed. The applicants in O.A.Nos. 798/2016, 95, 114, 403 & 444/2017 shall be allowed to continue in the services till the date they attains the age of 60 yrs. They will be entitled to claim salary from the date of this order till they attains the age of 60 yrs. The applicants in O.A. No. 826/2016, i.e., Dr. Anil Rabade, Dr. Premanand Thorat

and Dr. Anilsingh Raghuvanshi shall be deemed to have retired on attaining the age of 60 yrs, but they shall not be entitled to claim any arrears of salary till attaining the age of 60 yrs or arrears thereon. Except as aforesaid the applicants, will be presumed to have been retired on attaining the age of 60 yrs. No order as to costs."

The Id. counsel for the applicant submits that, the applicants have filed repeated representations and requested that they may be immediately allowed to join duty but till today no order has been passed by the Director, Health Services, Arogya Bhavan, Mumbai and the Superintendent, Central Jail, Amravati.

The order is self speaking from which it is clear that even if there is a delay in appointing the applicant, the respondents will have to pay them salary till they attain the age of 60 years. Admittedly, there is scarcity of Medical Officers and inspite such scarcity, there is no reasons as to why the respondent no. 2 has not complied the order. This shows

that there is total non application of mind or it may be a deliberate attempt to ignore the order passed by the Tribunal. We, therefore feel that on account of inaction on the part of respondent no. 2, the State will have to pay the applicants unnecessary. Hence such amount will have to be recovered from respondent no. 2.

Show cause notice therefore, be issued to respondent no. 2 calling upon him to remain present before this Tribunal and to explain as to why action for Contempt shall not be initiated against respondent no. 2 and as to why the salary that may be paid to applicants shall not be recovered personally from respondent no. 2.
