The applicant and respondent no.3 have been appointed as Assistant Block Development Officer and after completion of their training at Vanamati, Nagpur they have been posted by order dated 4/7/2017. The applicant was posted at Panchayat Samiti, Etapalli, District Gadchiroli, whereas, the respondent no.3 has been posted at Panchayat Samiti, Bhamragarh, District Gadchiroli. However, vide impugned order dated 17/05/2018 the respondent no.3 has been transferred in place of applicant and *vice-versa*. Prima facie the order seems to be mid-term and mid tenure. It is stated that the applicant as well as the respondent no.3 are yet not relieved from their respective posts. The respondents are directed to maintain status-quo as on today. In the meantime, issue notice to R-2 and 3, returnable in **four weeks**. Learned P.O. waives notice for R-1. Hamdast allowed.

3. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

4. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

5. This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

6. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

7. In case notice is not collected within **three days** and if service report on

affidavit is not filed **three days** before returnable date. Original Application shall

stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.
