3. The learned counsel for the applicant submitted that the order is passed by the Government on 3/1/2019. This order is Annex-A-5. In this order in para-3 it is observed that the applicant was acquitted in Crime No.65/2005, under Sections 376 (2) (g), 511 of IPC by the Sessions Court, Palghar on 23/01/2017. The Government did not prefer appeal to challenge the acquittal of the applicant and in the meantime the applicant retired from the service on attaining age on superannuation. In view of these facts, decision was taken by the Government on 3/1/2019 to exonerate the applicant from the disciplinary proceeding. My attention is also invited to Annex-A-6, letter written by the Under Secretary, Government of Maharashtra, Public Health Department. In this letter, direction was given by the Government

that as the applicant was acquitted in a criminal trial and he is exonerated in the disciplinary proceeding, therefore, his pension and gratuity be released forthwith. It seems that thereafter the Contempt Petition was filed by the applicant. It appears that in spite of expiry of 14 months, no action is taken by the respondents to release the pension and gratuity of the applicant. In this situation, as there appears no reason to oppose the claim, therefore, there is no point in granting opportunity to the respondents to file reply.

4. In view of this, the O.A. is allowed in terms of prayer clause nos. (a), (b), (c) & (d) and the respondents shall comply the order within three months from the date of this order. No order as to costs.

2. The Id. counsel for the applicant submitted that husband of applicant committed suicide after he was compulsory retired by the department. The Id. C.P.O. pointed out relief clause on P.B., Pg. No. 16 which are as follows:-

“(i) To quash and set aside the order dated 07.01.2014 issued by Dy. Director Land Record, Division Nagpur respondent no. 2 thereby retired the husband of applicant deceased Satish Komreliwar compulsory from his service and directed to the respondent to appoint the applicant in place of her deceased husband as per her qualification on compensatory ground.

(ii) To direct the respondents to appoint the applicant on compensatory ground in place of her husband Satish Komreliwar pending decision of the application by way of interim relief.”

3. The above both the relief claimed by the applicant are contradictory in itself. If the employee was compulsory retired as a punishment; there will

not be a question for appointment on compassionate ground.

4. In view of this, the Id. counsel for the applicant is directed to first separate out grievances of the applicant and file O.A. accordingly. In view of this, **C.A. along with O.A. stands dismissed** with liberty to file separate O.A. with separate relief.
