2. Our attention is invited to the order dated 31.1.2018 which is at Annexure A-2 in the O.A. In this order, it is clearly mentioned that the respondent No.4 was promoted as Dean on *ad hoc* basis. It was further mentioned that the said ad hoc promotion was subject to confirmation by M.P.S.C. Our attention is also invited to the advertisement which is at Annexure A-1 which was published on

14.9.2017. When this advertisement was published, the respondent No.4 was not even promoted as ad hoc Dean. On perusal of Annexure A-3, it seems that the respondent No.4 was called for personal interview on 16.3.2018. After perusing these documents it seems that the respondent No.4 was not regularly promoted as nominated candidate, his ad hoc promotion was not confirmed by M.P.S.C. and, therefore, we do not see any merit in the contention that the respondent No.4 was already promoted on regular basis on a confirmed post, therefore, the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 has no authority in law to again promote him on the post of Dean. We have also perused the order dated 7.8.2018 passed in O.A. No.218/2018. When the matter as argued before this Bench on that date, it was submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant that the applicant was intending to challenge the promotion of respondent No.4 on other grounds also, consequently, submission was made that the applicant would withdraw the application and he would file separate O.A. and challenge the promotion.

3. It is the contention of the applicant that fraud was practiced by the respondents on this Bench when the matter was earlier decided and it was suppressed that the respondent No.4 was regularly promoted. It is further contended that as the respondent No.4 was regularly promoted, therefore, he was not eligible, as already promoted and ignoring this fact, the M.P.S.C. recommended the name of respondent No.4 and

the Govt. appointed respondent No.4 as Dean. We have already considered the promotion order which was filed in O.A. by the applicant and it seems that the respondent No.4 was promoted on ad hoc basis, it was not a confirmed promotion and as before the process of appointment as per advertisement, confirmation was not issued by the M.P.S.C., therefore there remains no substance in the contention of the applicant that the respondent No.4 was regularly promoted as Dean and he was not eligible. In view of this, we do not see any merit in the application for review. Hence, it is dismissed. No order as to costs.
