2. Ld. P.O. submits that he has received no instructions from the respondent department. O.A. is filed on 27.12.2016. Thereafter twice it is adjourned and it was listed on board. R.2 is already served before 5.1.2017. Despite this, Ld. P.O. has no instructions from the respondents.

3. The applicant, District Superintending Agriculture Officer has challenge the order of transfer dated 15.12.2016 (A.1, P.10) by which her posting is changed from Bhandara to Nagpur. The applicant was transferred to Bhandara on request vide order dated 9.4.2015 (A.2, P.12). Thus the

order is mid term and mid tenure. The impugned order says that there is a compliance of Section 4 (5) of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as the "Transfer Act of 2005"). The learned counsel for the applicant urged that no reasons are mentioned. It is held in the catena of decisions that that reasons are not reproduced in the order. The same always find place in the file.

4. It is also urged that there is a compliance of Section 4 (5) of the Transfer Act only and order is silent about the compliance of Section 4 (4) of the Transfer Act.

5. The Ld. P.O. submits that the compliance of both the provisions can be covered if the provisions are complied with either way. Because reasons can be special or exceptional. Submission cannot be thrown away easily.

6. However, the matter does not end there. The Id. counsel for the applicant submits that as per the G.R. dated 31.10.2011, if any posting to ATMA is to be made, that should be by way of deputation. He proceeded to argue that in case of deputation, consent of the employee is required as per Rule 36 of the M.C.S. (Joining Time, Foreign Service, and Payments during Suspension, Dismissal and Removal) Rules, 1981. That compliance is not done in the case in hand. On the contrary, the order says that the posting is changed on transfer. However, the order cannot be issued contrary to the provisions in the G.R.

7. The Id. counsel for the applicant is shown to have been relieved. She has not joined and she is on leave and no other employee is posted in her place.

8. In the above state of affairs, impugned order is stayed till filing of the reply.
