2. Vide impugned order dated 31.5.2017, the applicant in O.A. Admittedly, the applicants have completed six years tenure at their respective places. According to the learned counsel for the applicants, the respondents have issued one Circular dated 15.3.2017 whereby a policy decision was taken for transfer of employees from one Division to another

Division and as per the said policy decision, list was to be prepared in respect of those officers who have completed 10 yearsq tenure in the sub-division and, therefore, the applicants are not due as per this circular. It is, however, pertinent to note that this circular is issued by Chief Conservator of Forests, Gadchiroli i.e. respondent No.2. It will have to considered as to whether this circular is against the provisions of the Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfer and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as, %Transfer Act, 2005+). The learned counsel for the applicants submits that in the Transfer Act, 2005, there is no mention of tenure in Division or Sub-Division and, therefore, it is not against the provisions of the Transfer Act, 2005. In my opinion this will have to be considered on merit. Unless reply of the respondents is received, it will not be proper to issue ad interim order.

3. Hence, issue notices to respondent Nos.2 and 3 returnable by **6th July 2017**.

4. Shri P.N. Warjekar, the learned P.O. waives notice for the respondent No.1. Hamdast granted.

2. Issue notice to R-2 returnable in **four weeks**. Learned C.P.O. waives notice for R-1. Hamdast allowed.

3. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

4. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

5. This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

6. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.
