2. The applicant is working as Livestock Development Officer at Wadegaon, District Gondia and vide impugned order dated 31.5.2017, he has been transferred to Panchayat Samiti, Desaignaj, District Gadchiroli.

3. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that since last ten years, the applicant is serving in naxalite affected area and, therefore, he is entitled for choice posting. However, he has been transferred again in the naxalite affected area which is against the Govt. policy as per various G.Rs annexed with the O.A.

4. The Ld. P.O. was directed to take instructions as to whether the applicant has been relieved from his post. The Ld. CPO submits that the applicant has not yet been relieved.

5. The learned counsel for the applicant places reliance on the order passed in W.P. No. 2770/2013 dated 17.1.2014 passed by the Honble High Court, Bombay, Bench at Nagpur, whereby it was observed that the employees who have put in more than three years of service in tribal / naxalite affected area should be transferred out of the said area. It is stated that the employees continuing in tribal area in excess of three years, cannot be made to suffer and those who have never worked in tribal / naxalite affected area, need to be posted at least once in their service. The learned counsel for the applicant places reliance on the order passed by this Tribunal in O. A. No. 342/2017 wherein directions were given to the respondent No.1 to take a decision on the representation of the applicant.

6. In the present O.A., the applicant has filed representation on 6.6.2017 for change of posting and giving posting at the place of his choice.

7. In view of the observations aforesaid, the application stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider the representations filed by the applicant on 6.6.2017 and 15.6.2017 and to take a decision within a period of **four weeks** for the date of this order.

8. Respondent No.1 is directed not to relieve the applicant till the decision is taken on such representation and the same is communicated to the applicant in writing. It is needless to mention that the applicant may approach this Tribunal, in case his representation is not considered positively.

Director (Dental), Medical Education and Research, Mumbai, from which it seems that the applicant was promoted to the post of Sr. Clerk and was posted from Vasantao Naik Govt. Medical College and Hospital, Yavatmal to Vasantao Naik Women's Medical Hospital at Yavatmal. Thus, the applicant is working at Yavatmal as Sr. Clerk just from 10.5.2016. It seems that prima facie, the impugned order in respect of the applicant seems illegal, since the applicant is not a Jr. Clerk and in the order, he has not been shown as Jr. Clerk.

4. The Ld. counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has filed representations on 5.6.2017 and 2.6.2017 for cancellation of his transfer and the same is pending before respondent No.2. He submits that the application can be disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on his representation within a stipulated period. The Ld. P.O. also agrees for the same. In view thereof, following order is passed:-

(i) The O.A. stands disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to

take a decision on the representations filed by the applicant on 2.6.2017 and 5.6.2017.

(ii) Decision shall be taken on such representation within one month from the date of this order and the same shall be communicated to the applicant in writing, considering the fact that the applicant is not due for transfer so also the fact that he is physically handicapped person.

(iii) It is needless to mention that in case the representation is not considered favourably, the applicant will be at liberty to approach this Tribunal.

(iv) Respondent No.2 is directed not to relieve the applicant till the decision is communicated to the applicant on his representation.
