2. The applicant a Medical Officer (Class-II) has challenged the impugned order of transfer dated 31/5/2017 (A-6, P-31) whereby she has been transferred from Rural Hospital, Rajegaon, District Gondia to Women Hospital, Gadchiroli on administrative ground. She has yet not been relieved from her post. It is stated that the applicant has already worked in the naxalite affected area and the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.2770/2013 vide order dated 17/1/2014 has given the directions which is as follows :-

"We therefore clarify the position accordingly and respondent no.2 to see that employees, who have put in more than three years of service in tribal/naxalite areas, are transferred

out of said areas as the employees who have put in three years service earlier in such areas, cannot be sent back to that areas. Employees continuing there in excess of three years cannot be made to suffer. Those who have never worked in tribal/naxal prone areas need to be posted there at least once in their service.”

3. In the similar circumstances, the order in respect of other Officer has been stayed in O.A.No.324/2017 by this Tribunal vide order dated 9/6/2017.

4. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the application can be disposed of if the directions are issued to the respondents to consider her representation for the transfer on her choice post. The copy of the said representation dated 13/6/2017 is at P.B. page no.36.

5. In view of the facts referred above, the O.A. stands disposed of with direction to respondent no.1 to take decision on the representation filed by the applicant on 13/6/2017 and to intimate decision to the applicant. A decision on the representation shall be taken within one month from the date of receipt of the representation by respondent no.1 and till such decision is taken, the impugned

order of transfer dated 31/5/2017 only extent to the applicant from Rural Hospital, Rajegaon, District Gondia to Women Hospital, Gadchiroli is stayed. No order as to costs.
