4. The learned counsel for the applicant has invited our attention to the order passed in the said proceeding dated 31/05/2010 from which it seems that punishment whereby the promotion of the applicant was stopped for five years has been quashed and the only penalty given to the applicant was that his annual increments were stopped for two years. The said period has already undergone. The fact remains that no opportunity was given to the applicant before issuing order of reversion. In view thereof, the order dated 08/04/2011 is required to be quashed and set aside.

5. The applicant has taken on record the Affidavit wherein it is stated that during pendency of the instant

application, the applicant was promoted to the post of Junior Clerk and has already undergone the punishment of stoppage of increments. Admittedly, the order of reversion was stayed during pendency of the application and the applicant was already serving on the post of Junior Clerk. In view thereof, the following order :-

ORDER

The applicants filed appeal against the said order and the Appellate Authority modified the order whereby the punishment of stay to the promotion order for five years has been set aside and only annual increments have been stopped. Admittedly, the

applicants have undergone that punishment as because of the stay granted during pendency of this O.A. they continued to be on the post / promotional post. Admittedly no reasonable opportunity was given to the applicants before issuing the impugned order dated 08/04/2011. Hence, the following order :-
