2. The Order has been passed by this Tribunal in C.A. Nos. 227/2017 and 228/2017 in O.A.Nos. 233/2016 and 301/2016 along with O.A.Nos.

3. It seems that considering the facts and circumstances and the arguments putforth, the applicants / original respondents were directed to convey DPC meeting within three months from the date of order. The period of three months is being

completed on 3/8/2017. The learned P.O. submits that the State has filed one W.P.No. 741/2015 which is pending before the Hon'ble High Court as regards the promotion and similar subject matter of these O.As. In the said W.P. the seniority list is challenged. Therefore, unless and until that seniority list is confirmed, the DPC meeting cannot be called. In my opinion, if the Hon'ble High Court does not pass any order in the W.P. prior to 3rd August,2017, the applicants / Original respondents can move for extension of time for holding the DPC meeting. However, considering the facts that limit is being completed on 3rd August,2017 with the consent of

respondents (Original applicants), three months time can be granted to the applicants / state (Original respondents) for conveying the DPC meeting. The State can make efforts to see that the W.P. is disposed of prior to said limit, if possible.

4. In view thereof, the Review Petitions stand dismissed. However, time limit to convey DPC meeting is further extended by three months in the interest of justice with consent of parties.
