2. The applicant, a retired Assistant Conservator of Forest, has challenged initiation of departmental enquiry no. 443/2016 to the extent of himself in view of sub clause B of sub rule 2 b (ii) of rule 27 of the M.C.S. (Pension) Rules, 1982 and also claims directions to the respondents to pay him revised pay etc.

3. The learned Advocate for the applicant submits that the Enquiry Officer has completed enquiry and has filed his report on 20.7.2017 to the Divisional Commissioner, E.G.S. and the Divisional Commissioner further forwarded the same for taking necessary action to the Secretary of the concerned department, however, no decision has yet been taken.

4. According to the applicant, the applicant got retired on superannuation on 31.3.2010 and prior to his retirement the charge sheet was

served on him on 1.9.2004, but the Enquiry Officer has been appointed vide order dtd. 5.5.2015. There is inordinate delay for taking action against the applicant as per the said D.E.

5. Prima-facie, the contention of the applicant seems to be correct, but it is also a fact that the departmental enquiry has been completed and report has been submitted by the Enquiry Officer to the competent authority. The only action to be taken against the applicant is to act upon the Enquiry Officer. The applicant will get liberty to challenge any action that may be taken in the D.E. He will be also entitled to submit his points for consideration before the competent authority.

6. Considering the above facts, it is admitted that without going into the merits of the present O.A. it can be disposed of by giving directions to the res. authorities. Hence, we pass following order :-

ORDER

(i) The O.A. is hereby disposed of with no order as to costs.

(ii) The res. no. 1 is directed to take appropriate action on the report submitted by the Enquiry Officer as early as possible and in any event within a period of 3 months from the date of this order.

(iii) The learned Advocate submits that the Secretary, Planning Department is the competent authority to take action on the report of the Enquiry Officer. In the circumstances, the Secretary, Revenue & Forest Department is directed to ask the competent authority as the case may be to take necessary action on the report of the Enquiry Officer within a stipulated period.
