2. The applicant is challenging the transfer order dated 30.05.2016, by which he has been transferred from Nava Mondha Police Station to Purna Police Station, Dist. Parbhani.

3. Learned Advocate for the applicant has submitted that the applicant has been relieved from the post on 07.11.2017 and he joined his new posting at Purna Police Station. He has submitted that the applicant has made representation before the respondents on 17.11.2017 and 25.12.2017 and the said representations came to be rejected by the respondents and therefore, he approached this

Tribunal by filing the present Original Application. He has submitted that in view of the provisions of Section 21(1)(b) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985, the present Original Application is in time.

4. Learned Presenting Officer has submitted that the applicant has not filed representation within a reasonable time and therefore, he cannot take benefit in view of the provisions of Section 21(1)(b) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985. She has submitted that the present O.A. is barred by limitation and therefore, she prayed to reject the same in view of the provisions of Section 21(1)(a) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985.

5. On going through the documents on record, it reveals that the applicant has been transferred by impugned transfer order dated 30.05.2016. He had not challenged the said order within a stipulated time in view of the provision of Section 21 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985. Not only this, but he has not filed representation

before his higher authority in reasonable time in view of the provisions of Section 21(1)(b) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985. Therefore, the present O.A. is barred by limitation in view of the provisions of Section 21(1)(a) of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985. Consequently, it deserves to be rejected.

6. In view of this, the O.A. is rejected as barred by limitation with no order as to costs.

- (iv) Applicant's request of online submission of application form is rejected and it is evident from page 30, which reads as under :-

**“This site says...**

**Qualification Criteria is not as per given in advertisement for Assistant Conservator of Forest.....**

**[OK]”**

(quoted from page 30 of O.A.)

14. In the aforesaid background, the applicant has clearly demonstrated that he is eligible to be a candidate, yet the M.P.S.C. has refused to accept applicant's application form / candidature based on the error.

15. It thus transpires that the rejection of applicant's candidature is contrary to recruitment rules as has been prima-facie made out.

16. Thus, the applicant has made out a strong case for grant of interim relief for issue of directions to the M.P.S.C. to accept his application form for the post of Assistant Conservator of Forest furtherance to the advertisement no. 21/2018 (Annex. A.2 paper book page 21).

17. In the above premises, we hereby direct that :-

- (i) Applicant's application form for the post of Assistant Conservator of Forest furtherance to the advertisement no. 21/2018 be accepted in hard form and the applicant be permitted to appear for written test for the post of Assistant Conservator of Forest.

- (ii) The result of the applicant may not be declared unless M.P.S.C. chooses to declare it in its own wisdom.

2. In view of amendment, issue fresh notices to the respondents in the present O.A., returnable on 5.5.2018.

3. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

4. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation/notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A.. Respondents are put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

5. This intimation/notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules, 1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

6. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

7. In case notice is not collected within seven days or service report on affidavit is not filed 3 days before returnable date, Original Application shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.

8. The learned Advocate for the applicant has pointed out that, though fresh notices are issued, the issue involved in the present case is brought into the limited compass, namely para 23 (A) of O.A.. Therefore, the res. no. 4 shall have to reply para 23 (A) only of the present O.A. by specifically averring as to reasons and circumstances in which the contention made in para 23 (A) and prayers based thereon can be legally opposed.

9. We order that, res. no. 4 should file his own affidavit stating reasons and circumstances due to which the contention raised in para 23(A) of O.A. and prayers based thereon can be legally opposed.
