2. The respondent no. 5 as well as respondent no. 7 has filed the affidavits-in-reply. The same are taken on record. Copies are served to the other sides.

3. From the facts of the case, it seems that vide order dated 31/05/2016 (Annexure-A-1) the applicant has been transferred from Central Jail, Nagpur to Ravi Nagar Hospital, Nagpur, at his own request on 14/12/2015 and since then he was not relieved. He was transferred in the place of respondent no. 10. Hence in

this O.A., the applicant has requested that he will be relieved immediately.

4. During pendency of this O.A., the order of transfer of the applicant dated 31/05/2016 has been cancelled. It is stated that the respondent no. 10 serving at Ravi Nagar Hospital was not due for transfer and, therefore, on his representation the order was cancelled and, therefore, the applicant was not relieved. It is true that technically, the applicant should have challenged the order of cancellation of transfer by amending the O.A. However, it is not done.

5. From the record, it seems that the applicant is serving in Central Jail, Nagpur from last six years. Time and again, the applicant has filed representation for his transfer out of Central Jail to any place at Nagpur. Initially the said application was rejected, but ultimately it was accepted and the applicant was transferred at

Ravi Nagar Hospital, Nagpur and even that transfer has been cancelled.

6. From the record, it seems that the applicant is facing number of problems while performing his duties at Central Jail and all these problems are conveyed to the higher authorities. However, without hearing the applicant, the representation of respondent no. 10 is accepted and the applicant's transfer has been cancelled.

7. The Id. P.O. submits that he has taken instructions from the competent authorities and at present there is no post available at Nagpur and, therefore, the applicant cannot be adjusted at Nagpur. In my opinion, the issue involved in the matter can be resolved, if the applicant can be adjusted in Nagpur during Annual

General Transfer of 2018, since he is already overdue for the transfer.

8. The Id. P.O. is therefore, requested to take instructions from the competent authority and to make a statement whether the applicant can be adjusted at Nagpur during Annual General Transfer of 2018 in the month of April/ May, 2018.
