2. It is contention of the applicant that all the bills were submitted by him time to time after the tour. The bills were misplaced in the office. There were representations made by the applicant time to time, but it was invain and ultimately the applicant was told to submit the bills and accordingly bills were submitted by him with letter dated 22/03/2006. After reading the application, it seems that it is nowhere mentioned in the application that the bills were submitted by the applicant time to time in the office and therefore no material purpose would be served.

3. The application is mainly opposed by the respondents on the ground that as per Bombay Financial Rules, 1959 Rule

39A the repetition is prescribed for submitting the bills and that period is one year and therefore the claim is now time barred. After reading the reply, it seems that in para-7 it is mentioned that the representations made by the applicant were not received by the office. In para-9 it is mentioned that efforts were made by the respondents for sanctioning the T.A. bills of the applicant, but due to insufficient funds i.e. grant, the bills could not be passed. The respondent no.5 consequently forwarded the bills on 16/04/2016 to the office of the District Superintendent Agriculture Officer, Nanded for appropriate administrative action, but no further decision is taken.

4. After reading Rule 39A of the Bombay Financial Rules, 1959, it seems that if delay is caused in submitting the TA bills, then the Accountant General has authority to condone the delay. It seems that if the claim is not exceeding Rs.1,000/- as presented within three years of their becoming due. After reading the note of the rule, it seems that the claims of government servant referred in Rule 39A (1) should be submitted to the Competent Authority for according

sanction to the payment of the claim after due scrutiny and check as required.

5. In view of this as it is not contention of the respondents that the work tour was not done by the applicant, therefore, it is suitable to direct the respondents to forward the bills of the applicant to the Competent Authority for taking appropriate decision.

2. By record, it appears that Shri M.T.Kale at Sr. No. 36, applicant Shri S.P.Chahande at Sr. No. 37 and one Shri G.S.Thulkar at Sr. No. 38. They all were promoted vide order no. b, I Vh 112013@3@2v¼2½] fnukd 17-04-2013 at P.B., Pg. No. 34 (Annexure-R-1).

3. However, after retirement, respondent nos. 2 & 3 communicated to A.G. different pay-scale for Shri M.T.Kale and Shri G.S.Thulkar. In case of applicant Shri S.P.Chahande different pay-scale was communicated.

4. Accordingly, A.G. has fixed pension of Shri M.T.Kale and Shri G.S.Thulkar at Rs. 6970/-. However, in case of applicant i.e. Shri S.P.Chahande pension was fixed Rs.

5940/- There is a difference of Rs.6970 - Rs.5940 = Rs.1030/- in monthly pension of Shri S.P.Chahande i.e. applicant than Shri M.T.Kale and Shri G.S.Thulkar.

Respondents are directed to examine this difference and take appropriate decision regarding pay fixation of Shri S.P.Chahande and in the interest of justice and equity communicate to A.G. suitably.
