reading this letter, it seems that on 25/04/2018 the Inquiry Officer was appointed, on 10/05/2018 it was noticed that there were defects in the proposal for the inquiry. On 25/06/2018 the Inquiry Officer received the documents. On 02/07/2018 the intimation was given about the defects. On 31/07/2018 the defects were removed. On 05/09/2018 the inquiry was for hearing and on that day the applicant was absent. On 10/10/2018 as the Inquiry Officer was on leave, therefore, the inquiry was adjourned. Thus it appears from the circumstances that serious steps were not taken by the respondents to complete the inquiry within a period of six months. However, in the interest of justice three months' time is granted to the respondents to complete the inquiry, on their failure to complete the inquiry within a period of three months, the departmental inquiry will stand closed.
