2. It is demonstrated that the applicant has already worked for a period of 7 years in the Naxalite / Tribal area. The applicant was transferred to Sub-Division No.1, Nagpur vide order dated 20/05/2015 and thereafter he was transferred to Sub-Division No.5, Nagpur vide order dated 09/01/2018. It is grievance of the applicant that vide order dated 30/08/2019 in the mid-term he is again transferred to Allapalli Naxalite area disregarding the fact that he already rendered service in the Naxalite area for about 7 years. It is submitted that the respondents while transferring the applicant in the mid-term, violated the Government Circular dated 10/12/2012. It is submitted that in this Circular the instructions was given to post newly appointed candidates in the Naxalite / Tribal area.

applicant was not allowed to give any option and therefore as the applicant is not relieved, interim protection be given.
