2. It is shown that by the transfer order dated 29/10/2018, the applicant was transferred from the post of Sub Divisional Police Office, Pandarkawada Sub Division, Yavatmal to Umarkhed Sub Division, Yavatmal in the same post. It is submitted that, the transfer of the applicant is premature i.e. before expiry of the two years and there was no circumstance to transfer the applicant before expiry of the two years and in this regard the transfer order is silent.

3. It is submitted that no reason is mentioned in the transfer order for immediate transfer of 23 officers and, therefore, there is a violation of **Section 22 (N) of the Maharashtra Police Act, 1951.**

4. The Id. counsel for respondent no. 3 submitted that the case is covered under **Section 22 (N) Sub Section 2** and as there was administrative exigency therefore, the competent authority has issued the transfer order and, therefore, no interference is required. I have already observed that, the transfer order dated 29/10/2018 is silent. It is not mentioned in this order what was the urgent administrative exigency for the transfer, under this circumstances as the applicant is not relieved. It is suitable to stay the operation of the transfer order so far as it relates to the applicant, till filing of the reply.

5. Issue notice to R-2, returnable on 05-11-2018. Learned P.O. waives notice for R-1. Hamdast allowed.

6. Tribunal may take the case for final disposal at this stage and separate notice for final disposal shall not be issued.

7. Applicant is authorized and directed to serve on Respondents intimation / notice of date of hearing duly authenticated by Registry, along with complete paper book of O.A. Respondent is put to notice that the case would be taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission hearing.

8. This intimation / notice is ordered under Rule 11 of the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal (Procedure) Rules,1988, and the questions such as limitation and alternate remedy are kept open.

9. The service may be done by Hand delivery, speed post, courier and acknowledgement be obtained and produced along with affidavit of compliance in the Registry within one week. Applicant is directed to file Affidavit of compliance and notice.

10. In case notice is not collected within **three days** and if service report on affidavit is

not filed **three days** before returnable date. Original Application shall stand dismissed without reference to Tribunal and papers be consigned to record.

2. The applicant is challenging transfer order dated 27/06/2017, by this order the respondent no. 1 has transferred the applicant from Amravati to Bruhan Mumbai. The facts are as under:-

The applicant is working as Assistant Charity Commissioner and posted at Amravati, the applicant was holding additional charge of Washim from 07/05/2016 to 31/08/2016 by the impugned order (Annexure-A-1) dated 27/06/2017. All of sudden, the respondent no. 1 transferred the applicant from Amravati to Bruhan Mumbai. The transfer order is mainly attacked on the ground that the transfer was premature; the applicant was not due for transfer. The second contention is that there was no administrative exigency for transferring the applicant, therefore, the impugned order be set aside.

3. The application is opposed by the respondent no. 1 on the ground that there were complaints of misbehavior against the applicant. The Joint Charity Commissioner, Amravati was directed to conduct the enquiry. The Joint Charity Commissioner after the enquiry submitted the report, which was forwarded to the Charity Commissioner, Mumbai. Later on the report was forwarded to the respondent no. 1 and on satisfaction that there was a substance in the complaints; the respondent no. 1 transferred the applicant.

4. The respondent no. 1 has denied that there was no administrative exigency for the transfer and secondly there was not just reason for the transfer. It is submitted that while transferring the applicant, the respondent no. 1 followed the procedure under Section 4 of The Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005. There is no illegality and moreover the respondent no. 1 transferred the applicant to Mumbai as per her own representation. In this background, it is submitted that application is devoid on merit and is liable to be dismissed.

5. I have heard submission on behalf of the applicant and the respondents. The respondent no. 1 has filed on record letter written by Charity Commissioner, Maharashtra State, Mumbai dated 15/06/2017 and this letter was addressed to Principal Secretary, Law and Judiciary Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai. In this letter, it is specifically mentioned that complaints of Shri Vasant Maldhure was enquired by the Joint Charity Commissioner, Shri A.S.Rajandekar, Amravati. The Joint Commissioner, Amravati submitted the report that there was substance in the complaints. It was alleged in the complaint that the applicant misbehave and it was misconduct within the meaning of Maharashtra Civil Services (Conduct) Rules. The Joint Charity Commissioner also suggested initiate D.E. against her. It is also submitted that there was Departmental Enquiry initiated.

6. I have also perused the enquiry report dated 06/03/2017 submitted by Shri A.S.Rajandekar, Joint Charity Commissioner, Amravati and the statement recorded in the enquiry. This entire material was placed before the competent authority and after consideration of all this material, the competent authority came to the conclusion in view of the

proposed Departmental Enquiry, it was necessary to transfer the applicant from Amravati to Bruhan Mumbai. The proposal was confirmed by the Hon'ble Chief Minister after weighing this material.

7. In view of these facts, I am unable to accept the submission that there was no reason to transfer the applicant from Amravati to Bruhan Mumbai before expiry of the normal tenure. On the contrary, it seems that the respondents have followed the due procedure and as the Departmental Enquiry was initiated looking to the nature of the allegation and conduct, it is not possible to say that there was no administrative exigency. The legal position is settled that if, the Departmental Enquiry is contemplated the Disciplinary Enquiry may transfer the Government Servant to avoid interference of the Government Servants in the Enquiry.

8. In view of this, it is not possible to accept that the impugned order of transfer has violated Section 4 of The Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005.

9. The Id. counsel for the applicant submitted that the respondents be directed to consider the representation of the applicant for the transfer from Bruhan Mumbai. In my opinion the Government Servant has right to make representation to the appointing authority for any grievance. The applicant is at liberty to make representation to the Government but as the applicant is posted, considering her earlier representation to transfer her to Mumbai, therefore, no interference is required in the mater. Hence the following order:-

ORDER

1. The application is dismissed giving liberty to the applicant to make representation.
2. Original Application disposed of.
3. No order as to costs.

It is shown that by the transfer order dated 29/10/2018, the applicant was transferred from the post of Sub Divisional Police Office, Pandarkawada Sub Division, Yavatmal to Umarkhed Sub Division, Yavatmal in the same post.
