The order of Tribunal was passed on 15.09.2015 and in order it was mentioned that entire process should be completed within six months from the date of this order. From 15.09.2015 six months period will expires on 15.03.2016. However, from the chart in para no. 3 above it seems that many payments have been made after 15.03.2016.

4. As per Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982, Section 129 (B) which reads as follows:-

*129(B). Interest on delayed payment of Pension:- If the payment of pension has been authorised after*

*six months from the date when its payment became due and it is clearly established that the delay in payment was attributable to administrative lapse, interest at the rate of 10 percent per annum in respect of the period beyond six months shall be paid on the amount of pension:*

5. In this case, as per Tribunal order six months period expired on 15.03.2016 and entire process was to be completed till 15.03.2016 only. However, even if further grace period of six months is given to the respondents as per M.C.S. (Pension) Rules, 129 (B) as mentioned above that period will end on 15.09.2016. As per the reply of respondents on P.B., Pg. No. 72 following payments are paid even after 15.09.2016.

Obviously, respondents have failed to follow the deadline given in order of Tribunal dated 15.09.2015 and further they have also not fully complied M.C.S., Pension (Rules), 1982 Section 129 (B) in case of above three payments.

6. In this situation, respondents are required to pay interest on the payment which are made after 15.09.2016 as per Maharashtra

Civil Services (Pension) Rule, 1982, Section 129  
(B). The Interest amount on these delayed payments have to be done @10% per annum.

7. Hence following order:-

**ORDER**

A. The O.A. is partly allowed.

B. Respondents are directed to pay interest @ 10 % on Pay & allowances, Leave Encashment and commutation amount paid to the applicant after following existing rules and regulations within six months from the date of this order.
