ORAL ORDER

Heard Shri G.N. Khanzode, the Ld. Counsel for the applicant and Shri H.K. Pande, the Ld. P.O. for the respondents.

2. The applicant is an Agriculture Assistant and has requested that the impugned communications dated 18.4.2016 and 7.6.2016 issued by respondent No.4 be quashed and set aside and the respondent Nos.2 to 4 be directed to release salary of the applicant for the period from 19.3.2016 to 31.5.2016.

3. Vide order dated 19.4.2016, the respondents were directed to allow the applicant to join the duty immediately. The applicant has joined the duty accordingly and has been paid salary regularly from the date of his joining till date.

4. According to the Ld. Counsel for the applicant, the applicant being ill, proceed on leave for the period from 19.3.2016 to 31.5.2016. He came to the office to join the duty on 1.6.2016. Alongwith his application, he produced medical certificate of fitness. However, the applicant was not allowed to join the duty and on the contrary, he was directed to show cause for his absence as per communication dated 7.6.2016. The applicant replied the said communication. Thereafter, again a show cause notice was issued on 14.7.2016 by respondent No.4 and his request for joining the duty has been rejected by respondent no.4 dated 26.7.2016 (Page 24).

5. The Ld. Counsel for the applicant submits that the appointing authority of the applicant is respondent No.2 and respondent No.4 has no authority not to allow the applicant to join the duty, so also to reject his leave application. The respondent No.4 ought to have sent whatever proposal to respondent No.2 for necessary action.

6. It is an admitted fact that respondent No.4 is not the appointing / disciplinary authority of the applicant and all the action has to be taken by respondent No.2 only. However, it seems that the respondent No.2 in his reply affidavit has also stated that it is for the respondent No.4 to take action. In short,

respondent No.2 seems to have been avoiding his duty to take appropriate action as regards absence of the applicant.

7. From the facts on record, it seems that the applicant has proceeded on medical leave without any intimation and there is nothing on record to show that he has intimated the office about his illness and all of a sudden, on 1.6.2016, the applicant attended the office to join the duty. If the respondent No.4 was not satisfied with the medical certificate, it was open for him to send the applicant before the Medical Board or to refer the matter to respondent No.2. However, instead of doing so, respondent No.2 entered into correspondence and called explanations from the applicant and so on. Considering all these aspects, I am satisfied that unless and until the absence of the applicant for the period from 18.4.2016 to 7.6.2016 and onwards till he joined as per order of this Tribunal is regularized, the applicant cannot be paid salary for the said period. The respondent No.2 is, therefore, directed to take appropriate action and to decide the absence of the applicant for the said period and after taking such a decision, shall decide as to whether the applicant's period of absence is unauthorized or it can be regularized. Depending on that action, the applicant will be entitled to salary, if it is decided in his favour. Whatever action to

be taken, shall be taken within **two month** from the date of this order. O.A. thus, stands disposed of accordingly with no order as to costs.

2. The applicants want review of the judgment in O.A. No. 829/2011 passed by this Tribunal on 15.6.2017. In para No.9 of the said judgment, this Tribunal observed that the employees, who refused regular promotion, are not entitled to time bound promotion and since both the applicants in the present case have refused regular promotion for the post of Air Compressor Driver in writing, the respondents have rightly rejected their claim for higher pay scale.

3. The Ld. Counsel for the applicants points out in para No.9 of the review application, in which the applicants are now coming with a case that the applicants were

wrongly promoted to the post of Air Compressor Driver vide order dated 29.4.1988

and the respondents have failed to consider that the post of Driver is non promotional post and the pay scale of the Jeep Driver and Air Compressor Driver are the same. This is for the first time the applicants are making submission before this Tribunal which may be against the pleadings in the O.A. It is a fact that the applicants' post of Driver is not promotional, question of grant of time bound promotion will not come into operation and if the applicants were wrongly promoted to the post of Air Compressor Driver, the question will remain as to why the applicants are taking benefit of that promotional post. In any case, the judgment and order passed in O.A. No. 829/2011 has been passed on merit considering all the *pros and cons* of the case of the applicants, as well as the respondents. If the applicants are aggrieved by the said judgment, proper way for them is to file an appeal / writ petition as the case may be, before the appropriate forum. Therefore, nothing survives in this review application. Hence, the Review Application No. 16/2017 is dismissed with no order as to costs.
