As submitted by Id. counsel for the applicant in response to complaint at Annexure-A-1, P.B., Pg. No. 19, show cause notice was issued on dated 17/02/2018, Annexure-A-4 and applicant has submitted explanation to the show cause notice which is at Annexure-A-5, dated 22/02/2018, P.B., Pg. Nos. 25 to 27 (both inclusive). Contents of P.B., Pg. Nos. 29 to 40 from 30 to 40 details of duty chart and time has been mentioned.

3. As submitted by Id. counsel for the applicant, the complaint is at Annexure-A-1 was not related to the applicant. However, applicant has been held responsible for the same. The final order has been passed by respondent no. 2 at Annexure-A-6, P.B., Pg. No. 41 and at P.B., Pg. No.

42 it has been mentioned about appeal; applicant has preferred an appeal vide Annexure-A-7, P.B., Pg. Nos. 43 to 46 (both inclusive). The appeal has been decided at P.B., Pg. Nos. 50 & 51, dated 06/12/2018. The punishment awarded by respondent no. 2 as per P.B., Pg. No. 41 has been continued. The Id. counsel for the applicant submitted that applicant is superannuating on 29/02/2020. The Id. P.O. submitted two points:-

A. The Id. P.O. raised objections that the order dated 12/03/2018 passed by respondent no. 2 has not been challenged in this O.A.

B. The Id. P.O. submitted that applicant was given fair chance before awarding the punishment.

4. However, since appeal was provided in original order dated 12/03/2018 and as per that applicant has preferred an appeal order dated 03/04/2018 (Annexure-A-7, P.B., Pg. No. 43) in the said appeal the same order has been awarded. Hence, it is observed that the original punishment order is merged with the order passed in the appeal order dated 06/12/2018. In the O.A. at P.B., Pg. No. 14 para no. 8 applicant has requested for following relief:-

- 1. Quash and set aside order passed by the Appellate Authority dated 06.12.2018 as illegal, bad in law;*
- 2. Further be pleased to direct the respondent no. 2 to release the increment of one year forthwith in favour of the*

applicant with interest thereon till its realisation, which has been withheld by way of punishment.

5. In view of arguments advance by Id. counsel for the applicant, it seems that applicant was wrongly implicated. Since original complaint is at Annexure-A-1, P.B., Pg. No. 19 was not found to be authenticated documents; already a concurrent policy is adopted by the Government that unless the complainant is identified; the said complaint should not be entertained in the department.

6. However, it appears that the complaint at Annexure-A-1, P.B., Pg. No. 19 is anonymous complaint. It is anonymous complaint and based on that applicant has been awarded punishment and now applicant is at fag end of service as applicant is superannuating on 29/02/2020 submitted by Id. counsel.

7. In view of discussions in above para, following order is passed:-

ORDER

1. O.A. is allowed.
2. Order in appeal dated 06.12.2018 is quashed and set aside.
3. Respondent no. 2 is directed to release the increment of one year forthwith to the applicant so that his retiral benefits can be smoothly processed.
