The Id. Counsel for the applicant filed three citations of Principle Bench, MAT, Mumbai in O.A.204/2018, O.A.No.610/2017 & O.A.No.635/2018. The same are taken on record. Copy of the same are supplied to the other side.

The Id. P.O. has submitted that M.P.S.C. has not filed the reply, though notices were issued and Id. P.O. has intimated them. The Id. Counsel for the applicant also filed documents related to the P.S.I., Sales Tax Inspector & Excise Inspector too.
