2. O.A. no. 30/2018 was called out. Before Shri Wagh, learned Advocate for the applicant opened his mouth to advance his submissions, Shri S.D. Joshi, learned Advocate (for the applicant in O.A. no. 107/2019) began arguing in excessively loud and dictatorial tone contending that he wants to argue first and he should be heard first, and at any cost the O.As. must be heard today only, because the applicant in O.A. no. 30/2018 is deliberately delaying the hearing of the cases, and she is enjoying the fruits of appointment to which she is not entitled and the order which she has procured by suppression of facts and documents.

3. In fact, so far, any request for adjournment was not made by Shri V.B. Wagh, learned Advocate for the applicant in O.A. no. 30/2018.

4. Bench had then pointed out to Shri S.D. Joshi, learned Advocate (for the applicant in O.A. no. 107/2019) that there was no reason or propriety to argue in the fashion, tone and in raised voice and high pitch.

5. On these observations by Tribunal, Shri S.D. Joshi, learned Advocate continued in high pitch and loudly and argued that it is a regular practice of lawyers to raise voice as and when required and it was not with a special intention and this practice is a usual phenomenon even before Hon'ble High Court and also at principal seat of Hon'ble High Court and Lawyers are heard though or whenever they raise voice, and that this style should not be misunderstood.

6. Approach of Shri S.D. Joshi, learned Advocate in persistently arguing his case and insisting the Tribunal that it must hear his case first in order (though chronologically it is at second number in the cause list) is grossly improper and also suggestive that the applicant in O.A. no. 30/2018 was bound to ask for adjournment.

7. Despite suggestion to mend, Shri S.D. Joshi, learned Advocate continued to argue in same fashion, and continued to repeat in his loud voice and aggressive argument.

8. This Tribunal then expressed that the approach and attitude of Shri S.D. Joshi, learned Advocate was not

proper being in grave departure of good behavior and minimum required etiquettes and if he continues to conduct in the same manner the hearing would be adjourned. Upon this Shri S.D. Joshi, learned Advocate expressed that he was expecting the same thing (adjournment) to happen and let it be done against which he would approach higher forum, and he consciously persists on his submission, since he wanted to start his argument first in order to save the valuable time of the Tribunal.

9. The tenor of arguments of learned Advocate Shri S.D. Joshi is in the nature of browbeating and is unfortunate.

10. The conduct of Shri S.D. Joshi, learned Advocate has turned disgraceful than barely being angry or anxious.

11. The entire tenor of address of Shri S.D. Joshi, learned Advocate is lacking due etiquettes and does not befitting to a lawyer of fairly long standing. In this situation this Bench is of the view that the Division Bench of which Chairman is presiding shall not hear these cases.

12. In the circumstances, O.A. nos. 30/2018 & 107/2019 should not be placed before the Bench which is presided by Chairman.

13. Hence O.A. no. 30/2018 & O.A. no. 107/2019 are removed from the Board, with liberty to circulate before another Division Bench.
