It is further stated that the provisional pension has been paid to the applicant. The learned counsel for the applicant however invited my attention to the G.R. dated 21/02/2015 (Annex-R-4,P-70) which says that the departmental enquiry in respect of retired employee must be completed within six months. The order of appointment of Inquiry Officer however shows that the Inquiry Officer has been granted to complete the inquiry within one year. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the application may be disposed of with direction to the respondents to complete the inquiry within stipulated period as per rules. The learned counsel for the applicant also submits that the applicant has been paid provisional pension only for first six months. The respondents to take steps to pass necessary orders for payment of provisional pension till completion of the

inquiry. In view thereof the following order:-

ORDER

Vide impugned order dated 31/05/2017 (Annex-A-1) the applicant has been transferred from the post of Instructor (Hair and Skin care) from Industrial Training Institute (ITI), Hinganghat to Industrial Training Institute (ITI), Sakoli. It is admitted fact that the applicant has completed her tenure at Hinganghat and therefore she was considered for transfer.

3. The learned counsel for the applicant invited my attention to the fact that the applicant has requested for her transfer at Nagpur in view of the G.R. dated 27/11/1997 and particularly Clause-11 of the said G.R. which reads as under:-

4. It is stated that the applicant's brother is mentally retarded and the applicant has been appointed as guardian of her brother. The Court order in this regard dated 31/07/2003 is placed on record at P.B. page nos. 15 to 18 (both inclusive) and therefore her prayer should have been considered on that ground. The learned P.O. submitted that time and again the applicant has been adjusted at Nagpur or nearby place on the similar ground and in spite the specific order, the applicant has not joined at Sakoli till today. It is admitted fact that the applicant's husband has been retired and is at home. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that in order to show

her bonafide, the applicant is ready to join at Sakoli for the time being. However she may be allowed to file fresh representation giving all details of her request and said representation may be considered within stipulated period or at the time of annual general transfers of 2018 and if such directions are given, the application may be disposed of. The learned counsel for the applicant also invited my attention to the fact that at the time of filing of the application the applicant was aged about 56 years and now she is due for retirement within one year only and this aspect shall also be considered. In view of the specific circumstances as has been discussed in forgoing paras, I feel that it will be in the interest of justice to give an opportunity to the applicant to file fresh comprehensive representation and to issue certain directions to the respondents. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant will join at Sakoli within one week and file representation immediately even prior to joining at

Sakoli. In view thereof, the following order :-

ORDER

The O.A. stands disposed of with direction to the applicant to join at Sakoli on or before 19/03/2018. The applicant will be at liberty to file fresh comprehensive representation to respondent no.3 through proper channel within one week from the date of this order. The respondent no.3 is directed to consider the said representation on its own merits as early as possible and in any case at the time of annual general transfers of 2018 without being influenced by any of the observations made in this order and shall give sympathetic consideration to all the grounds raised in the representation. The applicant has challenged in this O.A. the impugned order dated 03/07/2017 passed by respondent no.2 whereby it is stated that the applicant has been transferred from the office of Regional Dairy Development Officer, Nagpur (R/2) to the office of District Dairy Development Officer at Gadchiroli. The said order however shows that it is nothing but order of cancellation of deputation. 4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case so also the medical ground as stated by the applicant in his representations, it will be in the interest of justice and equity to dispose of this application without going into the merits of the case with appropriate directions to the respondents.
