2. The applicant wants review of the order passed in O.A.768/2017 on 27/04/2018. This Tribunal was pleased to reject the application. In the O.A. the applicant has challenged the communication 18/09/2017 issued by respondent no.3, the Collector, Chandrapur to the respondent no.2, the Divisional Commissioner, Nagpur. This communication however shows that on the representation filed by the applicant for grant of deemed date on 14/02/2017 to the Collector, the Divisional Commissioner invited information from the Collector vide communication 26/04/2017. In reply to this

communication, the Collector only intimated that the applicant's representation be rejected.

3. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the Commissioner has not passed any order on the representation and therefore the Tribunal ought to have given direction to the respondent no.2 to take decision on his representation. Perusal of the order passed by us shows that the claim of the applicant was earlier rejected in the year 2013 vide communication dated 15/07/2013 and this order was not challenged by the applicant. The recommendation made by Resp.no.3 is only interim recommendation and not the final order. It was for the Commissioner whether to accept it or not and since no relief has been claimed for non-action on the part of the respondent no.2, the impugned order does not reflect about the representation filed by the applicant. Prima facie we are of the opinion that there is nothing on the record to show that any inadvertent mistake has been committed by this Tribunal or any illegality exists. The respondent no.2 is still at liberty to consider the representation filed

by the applicant dated 14/02/2017 as per its own merits and the applicant will be at liberty to move the respondent no.2 for taking action of his representation.

4. In view of this observation, we do not find any merits in this Review Application. Hence, the following order –
