2. Vide impugned order dated 31/05/2017 the applicant has been transferred from the post of Round Officer from Yerkad sub division to Wild Life Alapalli Division. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that Yerkad comes under Gadchiroli Division, whereas Alapalli is the separate Division. He is serving at Yerkad since 3/11/2013 and has yet not completed two tenure of three years each and therefore the order of transfer is against the provisions of The Maharashtra Government Servants Regulation of Transfers and Prevention of Delay in Discharge of Official Duties Act, 2005 (In short 'Transfer Act') and also against the G.R. dated 22/5/2017.

3. The said G.R. dated 22/5/2017 shown that a separate policy has been framed for transfer of Round Officers in the Forest Department and as per the said G.R. the persons who are more than 50 years of age shall ordinarily be not posted in the Wild Life

area and the Officers shall be considered for transfer after completion of two tenure of three years each.
