2. The matter was on Board on 28/8/2017. On that date also nobody appeared for the applicant. The learned CPO pointed out that the application is not tenable as the applicant was claiming salary and allowances for the period from 15/10/1996 to 1/9/2015 as per the order of Hon'ble High Court in W.P. No.1250/2002. The Hon'ble High Court has already held that the applicant will not be entitled to any back wages and still the application has been filed. Since nobody was present for the applicant on the last date, it was kept for dismissal.

3. As already stated nobody appeared for the applicant today also. In para-3 of the order passed in W.P. No.1250/2002 on 13/8/2015 by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bombay, Bench at Nagpur. The Hon'ble High Court has observed as under :-

“iii) It is declared that the petitioner shall be deemed to be in employment as ad hoc Dental Surgeon right from the date of his

removal as such w.e.f. 8/4/2001 till his reinstatement as ad hoc Dental Surgeon on 1/9/2015 but without any emoluments or any back wages or other benefits involving monetary benefits and further that he being in employment as on 15/1/2007, is entitled to regularization as per G.R. No.NEC 1408/C.No.116/Medical Services etc. dated 22/1/2009 and consequently shall not be asked to face the MPSC.

iv) The respondents are directed to count services of the petitioner for the period from 8/4/2001 to 1/9/2015 only as ad hoc Dental Surgeon but without any emoluments or back wages or other monetary benefits and regularize his service in terms of G.R. No.NEC 1408/C.No.116/Medical Services etc. dated 22/1/2009 as expeditiously as possible and, in any case, within six months from today. Failure on the part of the respondents to regularize services of the petitioner within six months as per the G.R. dated 22/1/2009 shall automatically result into payment of salary and allowance to the petitioner after six months as regular Government Dental Surgeon and he shall be paid accordingly.”

4. In view of the said observations, prima facie it seems that the applicant is not entitled to back wages and still the application is filed. Since nobody appeared for the applicant and in view of the prima facie findings given by

the Hon'ble High Court, the O.A. stands dismissed with no order as to costs.

2. From the argument put forth on record it seems that earlier there was a policy to transfer those SRPF personnel who have completed 10 years of service to the District Police Force. Thereafter vide corrigendum said period has been extended to 15 years. Accordingly, applications were called on 7/3/2017 by respondent no.3 from the willing candidates. However, vide letter dated 17/3/2017 about 202 personnel have been transferred without following the procedure. The very object of the G.R. dated 10/7/1996 has been frustrated by not following the procedure. It seems that the similar issue has been dealt with by this Tribunal in O.A. 446/2014 with other O.As. by the Principal Bench of this Tribunal and it has been held that procedure is to be followed strictly.

3. In para-6 of the reply-affidavit the respondents have stated that the G.Rs. dated

19/9/2001 and 21/10/2016 are directory in nature and the applicant's have no statutory right to ask for transfer from SRPF to District

Police Force. His submission is most objectionable since the issue has already been decided by the Tribunal in O.A. 446/2014.

4. The learned P.O. submits that there was shortage of man power and therefore conscious decision was taken not to consider group of applicants for transfer. The learned P.O. is therefore directed to place on record the minutes of the meeting, if any, vide which such decision has been taken.
